Charlie Joe Asbury, 76, of Tazewell, VA, passed away on Tuesday, October 27, 2020, at

Moses H. Cone Memorial Hospital in Greensboro, NC after a brief illness.

He was born January 21, 1944, in Tazewell, VA to the late Charlie Frank Asbury and Dorothy June Bowling Asbury. He was a 1963 graduate of Tazewell High School. He proudly served in Untied States Army from 1965-1967. He was employed by Consolidation Coal Co. for over 35 years, retiring in 2005.
