Lavon Lowder Arnold of Bluefield, VA, born May 22, 1933, to Bowen and Virginia Sutherland Lowder of Bluefield, West Virginia, stepped into the presence of her Savior on Monday February 18, 2019.

Lavon grew up in Bluefield, WV; and worked for various businesses and doctor's offices through the years. What many Bluefield residents remember her for is Peppe's Pizza where she and her husband provided delicious pizza to the community in the 70s. In more recent years she would have been known for her Mary Kay business.

She was an active member of Parkview Baptist Church in Bluefield, VA, for many years, but also had ties to East End Baptist Church, Calvary Baptist Church, and Edgemont Baptist Church.

In addition to her parents Lavon was preceded in death by her beloved husband of 61 years, Don Arnold.
