Bluefield, WV- Mary Ellen Gilliss McCue, 91, died Sunday May 17, 2015, in Raleigh, NC. She was born on May 5, 1924 in Norfolk, VA, the only child of Joseph R. Gilliss, Jr. and Lucile Hoffman Gilliss.
