Bluefield, WV- Teddy Leverne "Buddy" Gilpin, Sr., 76 of Bluefield, WV, died Sunday June 2, 2019 at Bluefield Regional Medical Center.

Born January 14, 1943 in Bluefield, WV, he was a son of the late Raymond Lewis Gilpin and Ruby Cleo Gillespie Gilpin.
