Bluefield, WV- Agnes C. Footo, 94, of Bluefield, WV, died Monday March 21, 2011 at Westwood Center in Bluefield, VA. Born August 4, 1916 in Switchback, WV, she was a daughter of the late Andrew Footo and Anna Palco Footo. Ms. Footo was a lifelong resident of the Bluefield area and was a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church. She was a veteran of the U.S. Navy, serving our country as a Nurse during World War II in England, and also during the Korean Conflict in Korea and Japan. She returned to Bluefield where she worked as a Nurse at Bluefield Sanitarium and Bluefield Regional Medical Center. Ms. Footo received her nursing training at St. Francis Hospital in Charleston, and her Anesthesia Nurse's training at Mt. Carmel Mercy College in Detroit, MI. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by one brother, Matthew Footo; and three sisters, Eulalia Footo, Helen Bowling and Marie Boone. Survivors include two sisters, Ethel Cox of Princeton, WV and Martha Shrader of Lebanon, VA; one brother, Thomas Footo of Milton, WV; special nephews, George Bowling and John Cox; several other nieces and nephews; and special caregivers, both at home and at Westwood Center. The family will receive friends at Mercer Funeral Home on Wednesday evening March 23, 2011 from 6:00 until 8:00 p.m. A Mass of Christian Burial will be conducted on Thursday March 24, 2011 from Sacred Heart Catholic Church at 11:00 a.m. with Father Paul Wharton officiating. Burial will follow at Woodlawn Memorial Park in Bluewell where family members and friends will serve as pallbearers. The family would like to
