Princeton, WV - GENE BAILEY CAUDILL went to be with his Heavenly Father on Friday, February 24, 2014, after a short illness. Born at Bailey Switch in Tazewell County on June 14, 1930, and was 83 years of age at the time of his passing. Gene was a member of Westminster Presbyterian Church where he actively served as a Deacon and chaired the Property Committee. He served his Country in the United States Marine Corps and was honorably discharged on October 6, 1953. He established and ran his own plumbing business - "Caudill Plumbing and Heating" of which he actively participated until 2006. Gene resided at The Havens at Princeton, West Virginia from January 2012 until his passing. He attended Sunday school regularly and fondly referred to The Havens as home.
