Barry Raleigh McCloud, 69, of Bluefield, WV, died Friday July 23, 2021 at Bowers Hospice House in Beckley, WV.

Born September 6, 1951 in Bluefield, he was a son of the late William A. McCloud, Sr. and Johanna Schuster McCloud. Barry was a lifelong member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church. He served as a Eucharistic Minister and volunteered to maintain the church gardens. He was a 1974 graduate of Bluefield State College with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration.
