Joyce grew up on the family farm in Bland County, VA. She graduated in 1950 from Ceres High School and attended Radford University. She married Robert (Bob) Martin Mustard on November 24th, 1955. Joyce and Bob welcomed the first of four sons in 1956. Joyce was an accomplished Piano player. She played many years for Sunday Church service. Joyce was a talented Tennis player and played at a competitive level. Joyce's faith was important to her. She was a member of the Edgemont Baptist Church where she and Bob worshipped for many years with many dear friends. Most important to Joyce was her family, she was a dedicated Wife, Mother and Grandmother. Joyce was the glue that held her family together. No matter how large her family grew, she never missed sending a birthday wish or a happy anniversary note.
