North Augusta, SC – Memorial Services for Mr. Bruce Allen Puckett, 59, who entered into rest, September 20, 2022, will be conducted Saturday afternoon, October 8, 2022, at 3 o'clock. Mr. Puckett was born October 20, 1962, to the late Lee Edward Puckett, Sr. and Mary Bailey Puckett. He was a native of Bluefield, WV, where he was a member of Christ Episcopal Church. Mr. Puckett began his career in automotive service at Evans Chevrolet in Bluefield, WV, later working with Tom Welch Chevrolet in Princeton, WV, then with Cole Chevrolet in Bluefield, WV. He would go on to join Matthews Motors in Augusta, GA, where he served as the service manager. During his career, Mr. Puckett worked closely with Mercer County Vo-Tech Center in Princeton, WV where he was actively involved in Career Connections, assisting area high school students take the necessary steps to become certified and pursue careers in automotive services. He has made North Augusta, SC his home for the past two years and attended First Baptist Church of North Augusta with his family. After relocating to North Augusta, Mr. Puckett continued in his desire to help students by offering his expertise to Aiken County Career and Technology Center. He volunteered to serve on the advisory committee and conducted exit interviews to graduating seniors.

Mr. Puckett loved the simple things of life. He was a skilled woodworker, was

a talented craftsman and enjoyed HAM radio and all things automotive. Mr. Puckett appreciated the challenge of finding solutions to problems, could fix almost anything, and found great satisfaction in achieving a finished product. Mr. Puckett loved spending time on the water sailing and kayaking, especially at Clarks Hill. He was a devoted husband, father and family man, who will be fondly remembered as a true gentleman with a servant's heart.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his father-in-law, Buster Smith Jr. and his mother-in-law, Pauline Smith.
