Bluefield, WV- Charles Lee Altice, Sr., 86, of Bluefield, WV, died Saturday June 8, 2013 at Westwood Center in Bluefield, VA. Born February 2, 1927 in Bluefield, WV, he was a son of the late Raymond C. Altice and Bessie Belcher Altice. He was a veteran of the U.S. Navy where he served with the Seabees in the Pacific during World War II. Mr. Altice had been a lifelong resident of Bluefield and was a member of Cumberland Heights Baptist Church. He retired as an Engineer with Norfolk & Southern Railroad.
