Princeton, WV – Charles Edward “Eddie” Boyd, 91 of Bluefield, WV, died Friday, June 6, 2025, under hospice care at Ridge Care Assisted Living in Princeton, WV where he received exceptional care from the staff for the past 1.5 years.
