July 2, 1921 - April 4, 2016

Bluefield, WV – Charles Samuel Carlton, 94 of Bluefield died Monday April 4, 2016 at a Bluefield nursing home. Charles was born July 2, 1921 in Halifax County, Va and was a son of the late Oscar W. and Pearl Crute Carlton. He was a member of the First Baptist Church in Bluefield and was a graduate of Scottsburg High School and Bluefield College, and received a bachelor and a master's degree from V.P.I. and was a retired teacher of Tazewell and Halifax counties working 25 years. After retiring from the public school system he worked for the Town of Bluefield, VA as Zoning Administrator for an additional 25 years. Charles was a veteran of World War II having served in the U.S. Air Army Air Corp. in New Guinea and Iwo Jima when the bomb dropped. He was a member of the Bluefield Lion's Club, Masonic Lodge Harman Lodge 222, Royal Arch Chapter where he served as High Priest one year, TEA Executive Committee, Virginia Building Officials Assoc., Virginia Plumbing Inspectors Assoc. National Retired Teachers Assoc.

In addition to his parents he is preceded in death by his wife Ruby Stewart Carlton brothers; Wayne, Curtis, Oscar "Bill" and Ralph Carlton and sisters; Bessie Moody, Ella Johnson, Josephine Dawson and Evelyn Smith.

Surviving is a brother Bennie Carlton of Centerville, VA, and numerous nieces and nephews.
