



## Charles Frederick Grosholz,

March 9, 1922 - September 21, 2010

Palm Bay, FL- Dr. Charles "Doctor G." Grosholz, Jr., 88, of 1119 Nevada Drive NE, Palm Bay, FL, died Tuesday September 21, 2010 in Palm Bay. Born March 9, 1922 in Brooklyn, NY, he was a son of the late Charles Frederick Grosholz and Fredricka Heilman Grosholz. Mr. Grosholz was ordained to ministry at Calvary Baptist Church in Bluefield, WV in 1944, and continued pastoring for over 40 years. He was also President of his personal missionary organization, Impact Ministries. In addition to his parents, Mr. Grosholz was preceded in death by his wife, Majell Lois Neal Grosholz; and one sister, Mildred Grosholz.
