



## Charles Hudson

November 22, 1922 - April 24, 2010

Bluefield, WV- Charles Alexander Hudson, 87, of 408 Third Street, Bluefield, WV died Saturday afternoon, April 24th at his residence surrounded by his family. He was born November 22, 1922 in South Hill, Virginia. He was the son of the late Samuel and Minnie Pearce Hudson. Charles was a member of the First Christian Church in Bluefield where he served as a Deacon and co-chairman of the property department for many years. He served in the 17th Airborne during World War II. He graduated from Lynchburg College in 1950 and received his Masters Degree from VCU in 1960. He was a member of American Legion Post #9. He had a long history of service to the public in many capacities as a Juvenile Probation officer for Bluefield, a counselor for Child Welfare for the State of West Virginia and also as a counselor of Vocational Rehabilitation. In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by his sister Mayflower Clark and brother William S. Hudson. Survivors include his wife of 60 years, Virginia Dove Hudson, two daughters, Patty Baker and husband Steve of Salem, Va, Kathy Peters and husband Larry of Bluefield, grandson Chad Peters and wife Angel of Wytheville, Va, and granddaughter Angela Peters of Wytheville, Va. and a great-grandson Alexander Peters; two nieces and one nephew. A memorial service will be held at First Christian Church, Bluefield, WV on Wednesday April 28th at 11:00 am with a visitation at the church from 10:00 to 11:00, followed by placement in the First Christian Church columbarium.
