Charlotte Ann Maynor Scott of Bluefield, VA passed away on October 1st, 2022, at her home surrounded by her loving family following a long illness. Born October 16th, 1944, in Guyan, WV, she was the daughter of the late Naymon and Marceline Maynor. She graduated from Pineville High School in 1962 and Concord College in 1966. Charlotte began her career at Pineville High teaching history and girls' physical education. She later obtained her master's degree in education in 1981 which led to her passion of high school guidance counselor.
