For the past several years his favorite place to be when he was not at home was the Ponderosa (his brother James' place at Camp Creek). He had a heart full of love and compassion and would do anything for anyone that he could. Even during times of illness, Crozier was concerned and worried for others. He never met a stranger and made friends wherever he went. He married Annie Marie Carroll Pattleson on April 7, 1950. As they grew older together Crozier has always taken care of Annie, and Annie has always taken care of Crozier.
