



Rev. David Mason Armbrister

August 2, 1934 - June 9, 2020

Princeton, WV- Rev. David Mason Armbrister, 85, of Princeton, WV, died Tuesday June 9, 2020 at Princeton Community Hospital.

Born August 2, 1934 in Bluefield, WV, he was the son of the late George Stuart and Stella Prince (Bailey) Armbrister.

Rev. Armbrister graduated with an Associate of Arts degree from Bluefield College, 1954, Bachelor of Arts, 1956, and Master of Arts, 1958 from the University of Richmond, and received his Master of Divinity from Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, Louisville, 1961.

Rev. Armbrister has been listed as a noteworthy minister and religion educator by Marquis Who's Who. He pastored many churches throughout his career, from Blairtown Kentucky to Charlottesville, VA. He was the youth director at Graham Christian Church in Bluefield from 1971-1972; youth director at Trinity United Methodist Church from 1969-1971; had been an associate professor at Bluefield College since 1968, where he was an acting chairman in the Division of Social Sciences, and he was a long-time member of First Baptist Church, Bluefield.

Rev. Armbrister was also the author of Dr. Charlie The Life and Works of Dr. Charles Lee Harmon (2006 Anniversary edition for the Dr. Charlie faith Fund), and Lighthouse on the Hill: The Bluefield College Story, 2007.

He was a Trustee at Oak Hill Academy since 1989, a member and past president of Lions Club, member of Phi Theta Kappa, Phi Beta Kappa, and Kappa Delta Pi. He enjoyed drawing, walking, and reading.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by two sons, Glenn Armbrister and Craig Armbrister.

Survivors are his wife Catherine Elizabeth Blair Armbrister; sons, Kenneth Armbrister (Tessa), Blair Armbrister (Mary); grandchildren, Cara Robinson (Jon), Robert Armbrister (Marie), and Patricia Probst; great-grandchildren, Miki Robinson and Beau Robinson; and special friends, Dennis Yena and Nancy Mackaravitz.

A funeral service will be held on Saturday June 13, 2020 at 2:00 p.m. from the Mercer Funeral Home Chapel with Dr. Shawn White officiating. The family will receive friends at the funeral home from noon until the service hour.

Burial will follow at Maple Hill Cemetery in Bluefield, VA where family and friends will serve as pallbearers.
