Bluefield, WV- Earl Monroe Davis, 87, of Bluefield, WV, died Thursday March 2, 2017 at Bluefield Regional Medical Center

Born June 2, 1929 in Freeman, WV, he was a son of the late Carl Davis and Hattie Monroe Davis. Mr. Davis was a veteran of the U.S. Army, having served as a Paratrooper.
