Isabel (Issy) Looney Simmons age 83, passed away peacefully at home in her sleep on Saturday, January 7, 2023 after a short battle with cancer. Born on May 24, 1939 in Bluefield, WV, she was the daughter of the late William Harold and Clara Belle Honaker Looney.
