Bluefield, VA – George Monroe Burge, Jr. 95 of Sedgewood Townhouses Bluefield, VA died Monday January 22, 2018 at Westwood Healthcare Center. Born August 31, 1922 in Bluefield, WV he was a son of the late George M. Burge, Sr. and Jessie Methena Burge.

George was a U.S. Army veteran of World War II serving in the 102nd Division Artillery and Infantry Divisions, and a longtime member of Fincastle Presbyterian Church. He was retired from the R.E. Darling Co. of Arlington, VA. He was an avid golfer, flew small planes and was an excellent photographer. He was a great friend of the New Graham Pharmacy diner. He was the last member of his immediate family.
