Bluefield, WV- George Edward Dantzler, of 236 Ridgecrest Road, Bluefield, WV, died Monday September 14, 2015 at Bluefield Regional Medical Center. He was 57 years old.

He was born on October 4, 1957 in Charleston, WV. Rachel and S. W. "Bill" Dantzler adopted him at 6 months old. During his youth he was very active with the youth activities at Westminster Presbyterian Church. He participated in the church youth choir and in Boy Scouts. He attended Bluefield High School for a brief time. Later he went to MCallie Boarding School for Boys in Chattanooga, Tennessee for one year and two summers and was elected to the Senate the first year. Furthering his education he attended Bluefield State College in Bluefield, WV, Concord College in Athens, WV and West Virginia University in Morgantown, WV.

For many years he worked for National Boiler Service as a Journeyman Boilermaker. He would go to paper mills & power plants all over the United States to replace worn out parts to get the boilers back online. The buildings ranged from 1 - 16 Stories high.

In addition he is preceded in death by his Father S. W. "Bill" Dantzler.

Dantzler of Bluefield, WV; sister, Susan Emmalyn Dantzler of Bluefield, WV; daughter, Shannon Louise Cundiff and husband Jacob Cundiff of Goodview, VA; son, George "Jay" Edward Dantzler Jr. of Pulaski VA; three grandchildren, Aiden Christopher Nicholson, Emmalyn Irene Eubank, and Zoey Jane Cundiff of Goodview, VA; one niece, Stephanie

Lynn Gressett; two great-nieces, Brianna Comer and Kathryn Rumley; and two great-nephews, Philip Rumley III and Steven Powell Jr. of Bluefield, WV.
