Grace Gladys Roberts Gray of 5705 Fayetteville Road, Durham, NC, formerly of Bluefield and Kimball, West Virginia died Saturday, December 28, 2019. Born at English, WV, March 8, 1921, she was the daughter of the late John Nicholas and Elizabeth Jane Roberts.

She was a member of Trinity United Methodist Church in Bluefield, WV, where she was president of the United Methodist Women from 1978-1981. She worked for Koppers Coal Company and Mercer County Schools, briefly. She served as a Girl Scout Leader in Kimball.

Gladys was preceded in death, other than her parents, by her husband William Edgar Gray; three brothers James, John, and Richard Roberts. She was the last surviving member of her immediate family.
