Bluefield- Grant D. Hayes, 83, of 4427 E. Cumberland, Bluefield died Sunday August 19, 2007 in a Princeton hospital. Born August 16, 1924 in Bluefield, he was the son of the late Houston Hayes and Ethel Jumper Hayes. Mr. Hayes served as a Seaman aboard the U.S.S. San Jacinto with President George H.W.
