Bluefield, WV - Harry Lynn Kimberlin 83 of 3176 Cumberland Road Bluefield and 3713 Country Club Road Morehead City, NC died Tuesday August 21, 2007 following a short and sudden illness, at a Roanoke, VA hospital. He was a devoted and loving husband and father, and a passionate aviator.
