Bluefield, WV- Harry Lewis Moore, Jr., 86, of Bluefield, WV, died Tuesday June 26, 2012 at his home. Born August 10, 1925 in Bluefield, WV, he was a son of the late Harry Lewis Moore and Rose Breen Moore. Mr. Moore was a lifelong resident of Bluefield and was a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church. He was a member of the last full class of Sacred Heart Catholic School and was a member of Beaver High School Class of 1943. He was a veteran of the U.S. Marine Corp and served on the USS Mount Olympus during World War II where he fought in the Battle of Leyte Gulf.
