Bluefield, WV- Isaac Nickels Fuqua, Jr., 91, of Bluefield, WV, died Sunday January 4, 2015 at his home.

Born September 13, 1923 in Burkes Gardens, VA, he was a son of the late Isaac Nickels Fuqua, Sr. and Pansy Meek Fuqua. Mr. Fuqua was a graduate of Bluefield High School, Class of 1942 and Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University, Class of 1949. Isaac was an avid fan of the Hokies.

He was a veteran, having served as a Staff Sergeant in the U.S. Army. Mr. Fuqua was the owner and operator of Fuqua TV and Appliance Service.
