Janis was preceded in death by her parents, her mother-in-law and father-in-law, and her granddaughter Melena Nicolle Miller.

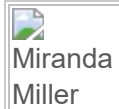

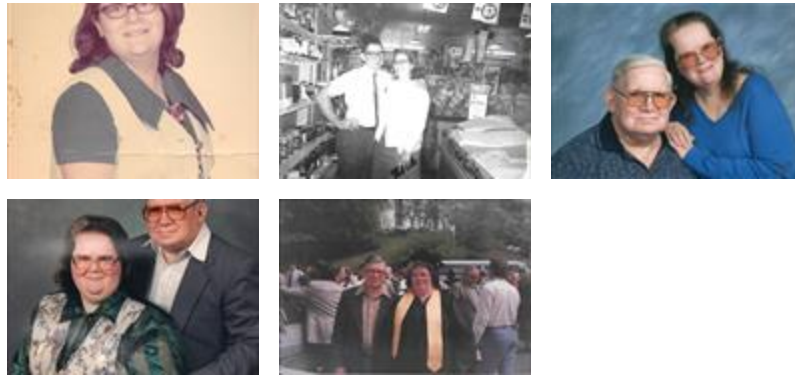

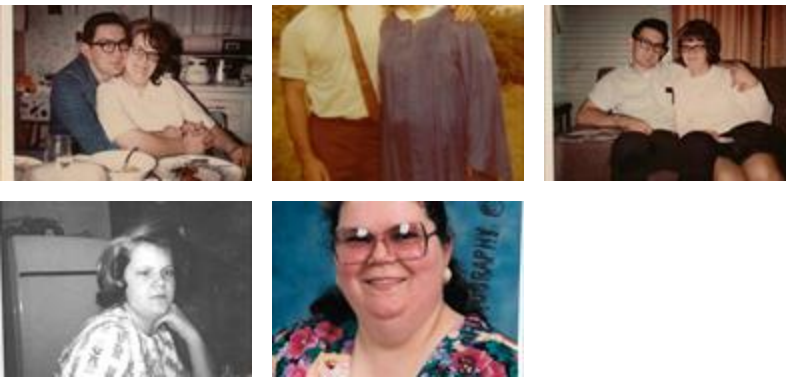
