Spanishburg, WV- Joseph L. Aliff, Jr., 83, of 274 Tractor Lane, Spanishburg, WV, died Saturday August 15, 2009 at his residence. Born August 31, 1925 in Hogback, VA, he was a son of the late Joseph Lee Aliff, Sr. and Martha Elizabeth Nunn Aliff. Mr. Aliff was a World War II era veteran of the U.S. Army. He had been a resident of Spanishburg for 27 years and had previously lived in Bluefield. He worked for N & W Railroad and retired as a Car Retarder Operator after more than 40 years of service. He belonged to the United Trainmen's Union for over 60 years and was of the Baptist faith. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his brother and sister-in law, Robert Thomas and Helen Davis Aliff; and his sister and brother-in-law, Mary Ellen and M.L. Blankenship.
