Bluefield, WV- Joseph Michael Pullano, Jr., 81, of Bluefield, WV, died Wednesday January 13, 2021 at Bluefield Regional Medical Center. Born September 21, 1939 in Bluefield, he was a son of the late Joseph Michael Pullano, Sr. and Genoveffa “Jennie” Soluri Pullano. Mr. Pullano was a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church and was a member of the last graduating class of Beaver High School in 1957. He retired as Lieutenant from Bluefield Police Department after 33 years of service, and had also served as acting chief for several months. He was a member of F.O.P. Lodge #80 where he served as President for several years. Mr. Pullano enjoyed sports, and especially enjoyed following the New York Yankees and West Virginia Mountaineers.

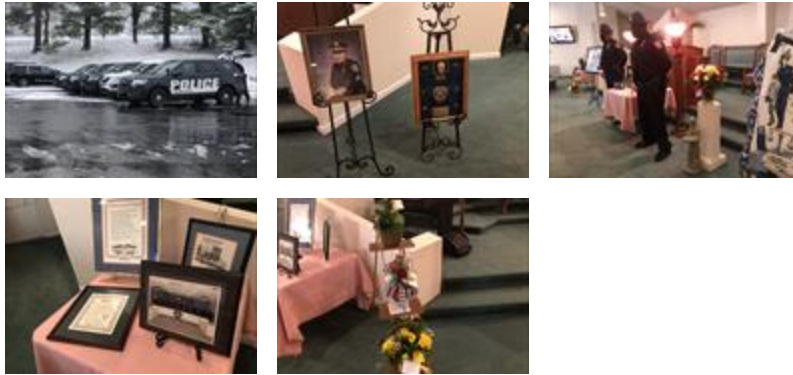
