Bluefield, WV- Katherine Peck Carrigan, 92, formerly of North Street, Bluefield, WV, died Tuesday May 4, 2010 at Westwood Center in Bluefield, VA. Born May 28, 1917 in Bluefield, WV, she was a daughter of the late David Kelley Peck and Kathleen Kahle Peck. Mrs. Carrigan was a lifelong resident of Bluefield. She taught in Mercer County Public Schools for many years.
