Princeton, WV Lillian V. DeModena Punaro of Glenwood Park Retirement Village, Princeton, WV died Friday July 30, 2010 at a Princeton, WV hospital. A native of Richmond, VA, she was born April 9, 1927, and was the daughter of the late Pasquale and Erminia DeModena. She and her late husband Augustine E. Punaro lived in New Jersey for 50 years prior to his death. Lillian had been a resident of West Virginia since 2006. She was a graduate of Madison College (now James Madison University), and was formerly employed by the C & O Railway Company in Richmond, VA and the American Standard Corporation in New York City. Mr. Punaro was employed by the Milliken Company in New York City. In addition to her parents, Lillian was preceded in death by a brother, Sergeant Ralph DeModena (US Army), who was killed in the Battle of the Bulge in the European theater during World War II. Lillian is survived by her brother A. A. "Al" Modena and his wife Mary of Bluefield, VA and a cousin Mrs. James (Ida) Arcaro of Silver Springs, MD who lived with the DeModena family in Richmond, VA during her youth. A private family interment was held in Richmond, VA at the Mt. Calvary Cemetery and a memorial service will be held at a later date.
