Bluefield, WV – Margaret W. Everett, 91 of Bluefield, WV died Tuesday May 24, 2016 at the home of her daughter. Born March 13, 1925 in Tazewell, VA she was a daughter of the late David Oscar and Alleta Roland Williams. Margaret was a lifetime member of Westminster Presbyterian Church where she was very active and involved, holding numerous offices for the women, she enjoyed sewing and reading informational books on history and loved crafts and flowers. She was one among two West Virginia women to have received their master electrician's license in the early 70's, and was a Copper Craft Representative for many years and retired from Bluefield Hardware after 45 years.

In addition to her parents she was preceded in death by her husband Jacob Henry Everett, Sr. and a granddaughter Stephanie Dawn Ewing, brother; Houston Williams, sisters; Carrine Williams and Minnie Jane Williams.
