



## Margaret Lee Hensley

February 28, 1921 - November 6, 2019

Margaret Lee Hensley, 98 of Bluefield, WV died Wednesday November 6, 2019 at her home following a long illness.

Born February 28, 1921 in Wyco, WV, she was a daughter of the late Mitchell Odell Huffman and Callie Valeria Huffman. Margaret was a member of Grace United Methodist Church and a graduate of Herndon High School and Concord College. She taught school in Mercer County then later worked as a legal secretary at the law firm of Hensley, Muth, Garton, and Hayes.
