



## Mark Gregory Warner

August 28, 1954 - August 10, 2021

Mark Gregory Warner, 66, passed away on Tuesday, August 10, 2021 at his home in Bluefield, WV surrounded by family. He had fought a year-long battle with lung cancer. He was born on August 28, 1954 in Key West, FL to William and Margery (Farr) Warner. Mark grew up in Key West and Wauchula, FL, where he graduated from Hardee High School.

Mark had a long career in advertising and marketing. He spent many years being an on-camera talent. His most recognized character was that of “The Dealman,” which he performed in commercials across the country. Mark was a member of Sacred Heart Catholic church and also a Knight in the Knights of Columbus. He has worked tirelessly on community service work with United Way, Kiwanis Key Club, and Bluefield Union Mission.

He was preceded in death by his parents, William and Margery Warner, and his brother William Warner, Jr.

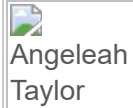
