Bluefield, WV – Mary Ruth Dillon, age 91, of Bluefield, WV passed away Sunday, May 20, 2018 at Roanoke Memorial Hospital. She was born August 11, 1926, in War, WV to the late Charlie Lloyd Hinkle and Cleo Ethel Freeman Hinkle. Mary Ruth was a member of College Avenue Baptist Church, the F.L.A.
