Bluefield, WV- Mary Elizabeth Ewing, 86, of 501 Woodland Drive, Bluefield, WV, died Saturday September 15, 2012 at Bluefield Regional Medical Center where she received wonderful care from her nurses, especially in the ICU unit. Born July 6, 1926 in Mercer County, WV, she was a daughter of the late Horace T. and Beatrice White Montgomery. Mrs. Ewing was a lifelong resident of the area and was an active member of First Christian Church in Bluefield where she taught Sunday school and was a member of the choir. She was a longtime teacher at Fairview Junior High School and Bluefield Middle School, teaching Social Studies, West Virginia History and English. She remained an active member of the Little Gardens Garden Club, the Bluefield CEOS Club, and the ADK Teacher's Sorority. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Reed Taylor Ewing; sister, Virginia Tucker; brother, Horace Montgomery; and grandchildren, Stephanie D. Ewing and Wesley Scott Hood. Survivors include her children, Suzie Phipps and husband James of High Point, NC, John Reed Ewing and wife Jean of Bluefield, Peggy Green of Roanoke, VA, Paul Ewing and wife Debbie of Blacksburg, VA, and Jane Hood and husband Ron of Lynchburg, VA; one brother, Robert Montgomery and wife Florence of Christiansburg, VA; six grandchildren, six great-grandchildren; and a wonderful extended family that included her nieces and nephews.
