November 2, 1921 - January 26, 2013

Princeton, WV- Mary Ferrante, 91, of Glenwood Park Retirement Village and formerly of Bluewell, died Saturday, January 26, 2013 at Princeton Community Hospital after a brief illness. Born November 2, 1921 in Modugno, Italy, she was the daughter of the late Vito and Porzia Ferrante of Modugno. Her family immigrated to America in 1938 where she later worked alongside her brother, Frankie, at Frankie's La Salute Club in Bluewell. She was a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church, Bluefield.
