Bluefield, WV - Mary Ann Griffith Boyce 86 of Bluefield, WV died Friday June 8, 2012 at the home of her son and daughter-in-law, surrounded with the love of all of her family. Born September 3, 1925 in Keystone, WV she was the only child of Ralph Waldo Griffith and Mable Nay Griffith Frazier. Mary Ann grew up in Grundy, VA and was educated in Buchanan County Schools.
