January 17, 1952 - February 2, 2015

Bluefield, WV- Mary Josephine Robertson, 63, of Bluefield, WV, died peacefully on Monday February 2, 2015 surrounded by her son and daughter-in-law at Brigham and Women's Hospital in Boston, MA.

Born January 17, 1952 in Milwaukee, WI, she was the daughter of the late Michael J. Stankiewicz and Eugenia R. Galainski Stankiewicz. 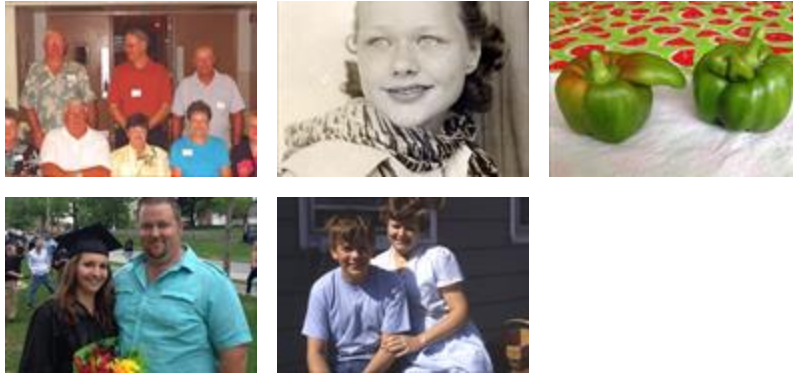
