Bluefield, WV – Melda “Ann” Williams 82 of 312 Oakdell Avenue Bluefield, WV died Friday May 9, 2014 at a Princeton, WV hospital. Born July 4, 1931 in Northfork, WV she was a daughter of the late Elbert Warden and Ada Johnson Warden.

Ann was a member of First Presbyterian Church of Bluefield and was a renowned artist and teacher, working with many mediums including sculpting, watercolors, acrylics and oils. She designed the Bluefield Lemonade Logo that is so well known in Bluefield. Ann had formerly worked and retired from Appalachian Power Company. She was an avid gardener, talented musician, loved to cook and was kind, caring and giving person. In addition to her parents she was preceded in death by a son Paul Steven Williams, brothers Dick, Don, Junior and Hugh Warden, and sister Jean Smith.

She is survived by daughters Lisa Arnold and her husband Greg and Amy Williams both of Bluefield, granddaughters Claire Arnold of Bluefield, WV and Holly Disibbio and her husband Jeff also of Bluefield.

Memorial services will be conducted Tuesday May 13, 2014 at 11:00 a.m. at First Presbyterian Church with Dr. W. D. Hasty, Jr. officiating. Interment will follow at Roselawn Memorial Gardens Cemetery at Princeton, WV. The family will receive friends at the church one hour prior to service time.
