Michael E. Hoosier, 67, of Bluefield, WV, formerly of Bland, VA died on November 8, 2022 following a long battle with leukemia. He is survived by his loving and devoted wife of 46 years, Ruth Ann Bradley Hoosier.

Mike was a licensed funeral director in Virginia for 46 years, having retired from the Richmond area where he spent most of his career in 2019 to move back to Bluefield to spend more time with his small grandchildren.
