January 23, 1920 - December 8, 2011

Bluefield - Michelina (Mickey) Monaco Iacullo, 91 of 2222 Fairfield Avenue, Bluefield, WV went home to be with our Lord and Savior on Thursday, December 8th, 2011. Mickey was a devout Catholic and had a special love and devotion for the Blessed Virgin Mary. It was only fitting that she died peacefully on the feast day of the Immaculate Conception. Mickey was a joy and an inspiration to everyone who knew her. She shared her love by cooking for family and friends, playing cards, and gifting her hand-sewn items. She truly "Enjoyed Being". Mickey was born January 23rd, 1920 in Sant' Agata di Puglia, Italy and came to Bluefield, WV at the age of 7. She was a graduate of Sacred Heart Catholic School and a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church. Mickey married Anthony Iacullo, of Cincinnati, OH, where they made their home. Widowed after 26 years of marriage, Mickey was left to raise her 5 children and later returned to Bluefield. At age 55, Mickey courageously began her work career by going back to school and learning to type. She worked as a receptionist at Bluefield Multi Care Nursing Home Facility, until she retired at the age of 70.
