Bland, VA- Milan "Tom" Milich, 86, of 4632 South Scenic Highway, Bland, VA died Wednesday July 22, 2009 at a Bluefield hospital. Born October 23, 1922 in Pleasant Unity, PA, he was a son of the late Emil R. Milich and Anna Milich. Tom attended Rosefield Grade School in Richeyville, PA and graduated from Centerville High School in 1940. He attended Washington and Jefferson College in Washington, PA from 1940 - 1942 where he was a member of the Alpha Tau Omega Fraternity. He enlisted in the U.S. Army Air Corps on July 22, 1942. He graduated from the Pan American School of Navigation in December 1943 and was commissioned 2nd Lt. Navigator. He served in European Theatre of Operations with 452nd Bomb Group(H), 730th Sqdn B-17. He completed 34 missions and was awarded the Air Medal with three Oak Leaf clusters and the DFC. He was discharged on October 23, 1945. On November 26, 1947 he married Louise V. Seach, his wife of 61 years. In 1948 he graduated from Washington and Jefferson College. Through the years, Tom had worked as a billing clerk, terminal manager and bookkeeper in association with the trucking business that he and his father and brothers operated. He was also a plant manager and sales manager in the coal industry. He semi-retired at 65 and fully retired at 75. He is survived by his loving wife, Louise Seach Milich of the home; one brother, Dewey Milich and his wife Elaine of Brownsville, PA; one sister, Lillian McCarthy of Florida and special friends, Lonnie and Joyce Keene of Bland, VA. A graveside service will be held on Tuesday July 28, 2009 at 1:00 p.m. at LaFayette Memorial Park in
