Nancy N. Looney, 90, a Bluefield, WV, passed away peacefully at her home on Monday, December 22, 2025 surrounded by her loving family.

Born April 3, 1935 in Ronceverte, WV, she was a daughter of the late Patton L. Nickell and Isabel Jackson Nickell.

Mrs. Looney was an active member of Westminster Presbyterian Church in Bluefield where she participated in Women of the Church and was in a Circle. Nancy was one of the original WestPress folders.
