



Nat Stallard Elam

September 14, 1920 - February 2, 2015

Bluefield, WV- Nat Stallard Elam, 94, of Bluefield, WV, died Monday February 2, 2015 at Roanoke Memorial Hospital.

Born September 14, 1920 in Wise, VA, he was a son of the late Walter Elam and Gladys Osborne Elam. Nat was a lifelong resident of Bluefield. He was a veteran of the U.S. Navy, having served in World War II. In his early years, he enjoyed motorcycle racing and stunt driving. Nat retired as a Manager from United Van Lines. He was a member of Cumberland Heights Baptist Church. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Frances Lillian Fox Elam; and one brother, Garland Elam.

Survivors include two children, Dennis E.
