?? He was a decorated veteran of the U.S. Army with the 2nd? Battalion Rangers during World War II. He was with the Rangers on D-Day at the invasion of Normandy, earning the Purple Heart, Bronze Star and Combat Infantry Badge.

Before moving to Washington, D.C.? he was an active member of the Bland Street United Methodist Church, a Past Master of the Bluefield-Mercer Masonic Lodge #85 A.F. & A.M., Civitan Club, and was a life member of the? V.F.W. Riley-Vest Post 9696 of Bluefield, VA. Mr. Reed was retired from the Norfolk and Western Railroad as a Conductor and was an avid bowler at Mountaineer Lanes.

?? In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife; Louise Hamlin Reed, thirteen brothers and six sisters.
