ROANOKE, VA - Olga Gorchick Clapp, 91, of Roanoke, VA, formerly of Bluefield, WV passed away Sunday, October 21, 2012 at her home with her children present. She was born on June 25, 1921 in Ramsey, OH, the daughter of Julius and Rosie Gorchick. She was a graduate of Welch High School and Bluefield State College. She was a retired teacher having taught Social Studies at Bluefield High School for 20 years during which time she was an active member of the Alpha Delta Kappa Teacher's Sorority and sponsor of The Future Teachers of America. During retirement, she stayed busy with golf, gardening, and grandchildren. She also enjoyed reading, jigsaw and crossword puzzles even up to a few days before her death.
