October 25, 1921 - February 19, 2010

Summerville, SC - Opal Anderson Hostetter, 88, of Ladson, SC, and formerly of Bluefield, WV passed away Friday, February 19, 2010 at a Summerville, SC hospital. Mrs. Hostetter was born October 25, 1921 in Bluefield, VA, a daughter of the late Edward Anderson and Virgie Henry Anderson. She was a member of Trinity United Methodist Church of Bluefield, and was a member of the Searchers Class at Bethany United Methodist Church in Summerville, SC. She was a graduate of Bluefield State College, and was an 18-year veteran of the Mercer County school system where she taught elementary school, and also taught at an ungraded high school for the mentally and emotionally handicapped. She was formerly employed by the Mercer County Sheriff's Department. Opal belonged to the Daughters of the Confederacy, and was a member of the Bluefield Garden Club. After her retirement, Mrs. Hostetter volunteered as a mentor at Summerville Elementary School. Survivors include her husband of 65 years, William Donald Hostetter of Ladson; one daughter, Lynn Hostetter Munson and husband Eric of North Charleston; two grandchildren, Richard Munson and Laura Schimmeyer; and one great-grandchild, Rowan. Graveside services will be conducted Friday February 26, 2010 at 10:00 a.m. at Roselawn Memorial Gardens Cemetery, Princeton, WV with Dr. Don Scott officiating.
