Bluefield, VA - Patrick A. Romano, Sr. 91 of Westwood Nursing Home, died Wednesday July 4, 2012 surrounded by his family. Born August 7, 1920 in laeger, WV, he was a son of the late Vincenzo Romano and Adaline Talarico Romano. He was a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church of Bluefield and a resident of Bluefield for the past 60 years. He was a graduate of Bluefield College, Class President, and graduated from Virginia Polytechnic Institute of Blacksburg, VA with a B.S. degree in Civil Engineering. Pat served as an industrial sales representative for Texaco for over 30 years, retiring in 1982. He was a veteran of the U.S Army having served in WW II where he received a Purple Heart. Pat had a great passion for music and was a member of the Army band. Pat was an Honorary Life Member of the Knights of Columbus Council #1404, Bluefield, West Virginia. In addition he was the oldest living "life member" of the Elks Lodge 269 having joined in 1947. He was an active member of the Sons of Italy, and enjoyed music and dance. He played in the Army Band and sang in the Church choir. His favorite musical instruments were the trumpet and violin. He was always first and the last on the dance floor. In retirement Pat enjoyed woodworking and spending time with his family and grandchildren.
