Bluefield, WV Phyllis I. Oliver 89 of 428 Union Street Bluefield, WV died Tuesday June 21, 2011 at a Bluefield hospital. Born June 30, 1921 in Canebrake, WV she was a daughter of the late Dallas E. Arney and Mary L. Cassell Arney. She was a member of First Presbyterian Church of Bluefield and had worked during World War II with American Electric Power Company on the Glynn Lynn, VA power plant. She was a member of Circle # 2 of the Church, was a former Cub Scout leader, was the Medical Officer for Civil Defense for the East End of Bluefield, past president of Mercer County C.E.O.S. and the Bluefield C.E.O.S. Club and was chairperson for the Sesquicentennial Quilt Fair in 1976. In addition to her parents, Phyllis was preceded in death by her husband John W. Oliver, a son Jeffrey L. Oliver, five brothers, two sisters, and three half sisters. She is survived by a daughter Pamala Jane Godbey and her husband Robert of Bluefield, WV, three sons; Daniel B.
